

Trip Guide #1: Murtho Park and Border Cliffs Drive: (Distance to Border Cliffs 60km)

Note: Wilkadene Woolshed Brewery is closed on Monday and Tuesday

- **A** - Leave Barmera BOG site and travel thru Renmark across the Paringa Historic Expanding Bridge. On your left you can view **Paringa Silo Art**. 30km
- Les Webb our BOG member spearheaded this Art Project).

- **B** - Take the next Left onto Murtho Road (130m). On the map you can see the turnoff to Headings Cliff Lookout. Expansive views onto the Murray. 14km
- You can continue on this road for a further 1.5km of dirt road to Murtho Forest Boat Ramp and Camping area. There are toilets near the Boat Ramp.



- Return to the highway and turn left 14km
- **C** - Wilkadene Woolshed. (**Note: Wilkadene Woolshed Brewery is closed Mon & Tues**)
- Retrace your tracks back to Murtho Road, turn left.
- **D** - Take Wilkinson Road to get to Wilkadene Woolshed Brewery, located in a 100 year old woolshed overlooking the Murray.
- The Brewery has a range of award winning craft beers.
- You may BYO lunch, use their free BBQ facility or choose your own local produce from their store to create your own platter.
